

Health Care and Financial Support Programs

Highlights

Various financial assistance programs are available in the United States to help cover medical services, hospital care, and prescription medicines.

Families may also receive financial support related to childcare, parental leave benefits, and tax credits.

Eligibility and payment amounts depend on household income, family size, employment status, and other criteria.

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What is Health Care Assistance?

In the United States, health care assistance programs help individuals and families access medical services, hospital care, and certain prescription medications at reduced or no cost.

This assistance may include:

Free or low-cost medical care through public health programs or insurance plans. Hospital services provided through public or participating private hospitals. Partial coverage for medical services, procedures, and prescription medicines, depending on eligibility.

Health care assistance programs are administered at both the federal and state levels, and coverage may vary by location.

What Other Benefits Are Available?

Family Tax Benefits
